- #2 Pencils (1 Packages) Ticonderoga is a good quality pencil. Please remember that many of the "Cute" pencils are not good quality.
- Pencil top erasers (1 Packages)
- 1 box Crayola Markers (fine tip)
- 2 -12 pack Crayola Twistable Colored pencils
- 1 pair of Fiskar scissors (preferably the intermediate version)
- 4 packages of glue sticks
- 4 rolls of paper towels
- 4 boxes Kleenex
- 1 container of Clorox Wipes
- 1 bathroom size pump SOAP (not sanitizer)
- 1 multi-surface (non-bleach) spray cleaner
- 3 wide ruled composition notebooks- any color- NOT spiral...see attached copy of this.
